

General Curtis E. LeMay - KØGRL - W6EZV 1906-1990 - Chief of Staff USAF, Vice Presidential candidate in 1968, a Buckeye from Columbus, Ohio - A civil engineering student at Ohio State University with decorations & acclaim too numerous to mention. Also known as the father of Strategic Air Command.

General LeMay had special interest in the radio theory and operation of Single Side Band. This mode eventually became the standards for most voice transmission. It is ironic however the aero industry still today uses AM mode in their air to ground transmitters in the commercial field, world wide.
