

Mark S. Geisler N1FJD *1955-1998* To James and Margaret Geisler, originally from Park Ridge (Chicago) Illinois. Believed a student at Maine East H.S. Park Ridge, 1974 graduate. Eventually Mark would suffer from Muscular Dystrophy.

Mr. Geisler N1FJD attended Southern Illinois University, moving to Cape Cod in 1985. Mark was well known in the amateur radio ranks and active in Brewster's "All Citizens Access:" The Brewster Chamber of Commerce and C.O.R.D., Cape Organization for Rights of the Disabled., to advance the independence, productivity and integration of people with disabilities including deaf and hard of hearing into mainstream society.

Mark's parents, James and Margaret operated the successful "Ocean Gold Bed and Breakfast" on the Cape. Mark Geisler age 43 expired 21 Oct 1998 at Cape Cod Hospital in Hyannis of complications from Muscular dystrophy. Surviving besides both parents, two sisters Christine and Heidi. A brother Steven of Illinois, a niece and two nephews.

A memorial service with Scottish piper was held at the Geisler home 74 Locust Lane Brewster.
