Stuart F. Meyer W2GHK *1918-1994* Stu's technical achievements and executive talents helped shape the early wireless industry at Dumont Radio Corp. Link Radio Corp. - Hammarlund and Ericsson Corporation.

Along the way Stu was known far and wide with his DX and contesting operations from rare spots throughout the world. Some with Gus Browning W4BPD, Herman Bohning W2MZV and other talented operators. Who can ever forget the "Dxpedition of the Month." Stu was honored by being inducted into the CQ Magazine Hall of Fame. QCWA Presidency and ARRL membership and honors he also enjoyed.

Mr. Meyer was a leader in early trunked radio systems for land mobile radio, the predecessor to today's modern cellular telephone infrastructure. Stuart also was an active member of the IEEE Vehicular Technology Society and was a leader and longstanding member of the Radio Club of America. (The worlds oldest radio society) The Stuart Meyer Memorial Award is sponsored by IEEE and Ericsson. The award is a plaque and \$2,500 prize presented to the deserving in honor of our wireless pioneer whose career spanned 5 decades.
