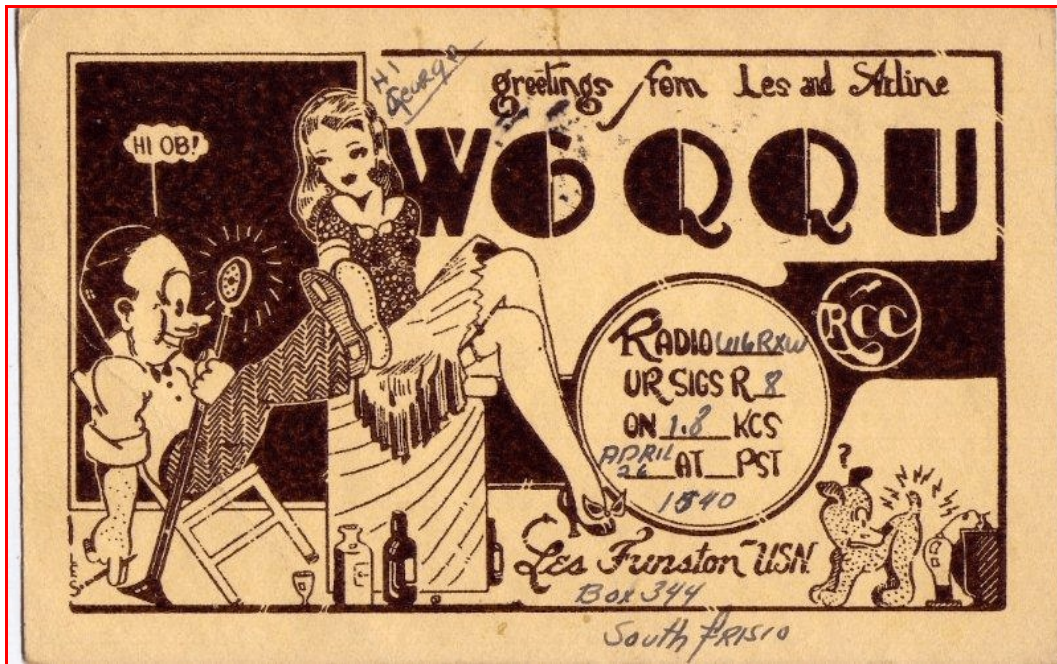


Leslie L. Funston *W6QQU* *W7AEM* 1907-1988 -The 1930 Census had Les born in Kansas. Was a QSL card artist and printer in the 30s. He was W7AEM at Hardin Montana in the 1930 Flying Horse Call book.



By 1940 Les was serving with the US Naval Radio Station in San Mateo County California, living with wife Arline.

Found notes and pictures that he became a Warrant Officer in Hawaiian Command.

Funston, assigned to USN Navy War Dept on Constitution Ave DC by 1956. He was decorated, One George Brown on Ancestry was looking for his friend Les Funston from the Navy days. .
